Australian visual artist Natalie Will's current exhibition at Centennial, transcends traditional landscape art and invites exploration into the realms of place, identity, and the natural world. Natalie's innovative approach merges the vibrant energy of contemporary landscapes with the intricate techniques of collage and mixed media, resulting in a visual experience that is both immersive and thought-provoking.

At the heart of Natalie's artistry lies a bold and playful colour pallet that breathe life into her compositions. Each piece serves as a window into a surreal dreamscape, where the abstraction of her imagery encourages viewers to engage with the artwork on a personal level. The interplay of color and form offers just enough familiarity for recognition, while simultaneously allowing each observer to weave their own narrative, creating a unique connection to the work.



In her collage pieces, Natalie meticulously gathers her images from op shops and recycling centers. Drawing inspiration from children's encyclopedias, textbooks, and magazines, she crafts unique compositions that often oscillate between silliness and the obscure.
