## Membership

Membership is open to artists and creatives who wish to actively participate in and support the Southern Highlands arts community. Membership is valid for the period specified in the membership package and is non-transferable and non-refundable.

The Pop-Up Project reserves the right to approve or decline membership applications and may remove members whose conduct is inconsistent with the values or objectives of the collective.

## Independent Artists

All members operate as independent artists or businesses and are responsible for their own studio operations, insurance, sales and compliance with applicable laws or safety requirements. The Pop-Up Project and EA Experience do not manage or take responsibility for individual artist businesses.

## Promotion and Marketing

By becoming a member, artists grant permission for The Pop-Up Project and EA Experience to use submitted images, artwork, artist profiles and related content for the purpose of promoting the artist, The Pop-Up Project and regional arts initiatives across websites, social media, publications and marketing materials.

Artists must ensure that any images or materials submitted are their original work and do not infringe the rights of any third party.

## Online Platforms

Members may be featured across Pop-Up Project online platforms including the website, social media channels and email communications. The Pop-Up Project reserves the right to edit, remove or decline content that is inaccurate, inappropriate, misleading or inconsistent with the project's values.

## Liability

Participation in The Pop-Up Project and use of its online platforms is at the member's own risk. The Pop-Up Project and EA Experience are not liable for any loss, damage, injury or claims arising from an artist's activities, artwork, events, sales or studio operations.

Members are responsible for maintaining appropriate insurance where required.

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## Insurance Requirement

A condition of participating in The Pop-Up Project and opening your studio to the public is that you must hold appropriate public liability insurance.

Before opening your studio as part of The Pop-Up Project, you must provide the organiser with a current Certificate of Currency confirming:

- Public liability insurance of at least \$20 million
- The policy is current and valid
- Coverage applies for any period your studio is open to the public

It is the artist's responsibility to ensure their insurance remains valid and up to date at all times.

## Artwork and Sales

Artists retain full ownership and copyright of their artwork. All artwork must be original. The Pop-Up Project and EA Experience do not take commission on sales and are not responsible for any sales transactions between artists and buyers.

## Privacy

Personal information provided during membership registration may be used by The Pop-Up Project and EA Experience to administer membership, communicate with members and promote artists through project channels in accordance with Australian privacy laws.

## Membership Terms

Membership is non-transferable and non-refundable. The Pop-Up Project reserves the right to update these terms or remove membership where behaviour is inconsistent with the project's values.
